MONDAYS:

Tippi Jam (Tippi Toes)

Preschool & Pre-K

Mondays, January 23, 30, February 6, 13, 27, March 6 (3:00-3:45)

Tippi Jam is an introductory dance class where three- to five-year-old students learn the basics - listening to a teacher, basic dance choreography, meeting other children and expressing their creativity. The goal is the students learn about the dance environment, learn choreography and complete dances, make new friends, experience independence and gain confidence. The classes are filled with energetic, imaginative, positive, and fun songs! \$120 / Min # of students: 6;

Tippi Pro (Tippi Toes) Kindergarten – 4th Grade

Tippi Pro is a class for children ages 5-10 years old. Tippi Pro is a ballet and jazz dance class for school-aged dancers ready for a bit of challenge, while still enjoying the fun and encouraging atmosphere of Tippi Toes! The goal over time would be to learn the basic fundamental foundation of true ballet techniques and to further improve upon various other styles of dance.
