

Job Opening: Preschool and Before & After School Assistant

This unique split position serves in our Before/After School Program, providing student supervision and enrichment support, followed by coverage as a floater/PE teacher within our Preschool classrooms during the school day. This merging of roles allows for a benefits-eligible position. The ideal candidate is enthusiastic about working with children across a range of ages, highly collaborative, and committed to ensuring a safe, engaging, and nurturing environment.

Key Responsibilities:

During Before/After Care (Morning Mustang Club, 7:30 – 8:30 am and 3:00 – 4:00 pm)

- Supervise and engage students in Preschool through 8th Grade during before- and after-school programs, ensuring safety, comfort, positive interactions, and adherence to required staff-to-child ratios.
- Record and maintain daily attendance and sign-out documentation.
- Coordinate smooth day-to-day program operations.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

During Preschool Hours (8:30 am – 3:00 pm)

- Provide classroom support as a preschool floater, assisting where coverage is needed.
- Teach weekly Preschool Physical Education classes for six groups, using prepared lesson plans and activities.
- Supervise students to ensure safety, focus, and active engagement.
- Assist with whole-group and small-group instruction.
- Support daily routines including lunch, recess, rest time, and carpool.
- Perform clerical and classroom support duties (copies, attendance, preparing materials, bulletin boards, etc.).
- Collaborate with Preschool teachers to ensure smooth classroom operations.
- Attend team meetings and staff professional development days.



• Ensure compliance with MSDE Office of Child Care licensing requirements, including completing all required forms and trainings.

Qualifications:

- High school diploma or GED required, bachelor's degree preferred.
- Demonstrated experience working with preschool-age children and/or school-age students in group settings.
- Ability to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing
- Ability to work collaboratively with other faculty, staff, and parents
- Follow basic principles of childhood development
- Flexibility and enthusiasm for working in both classroom and before/after-school settings.

Physical Demands: The position requires the ability to perform various physical tasks, including walking, climbing stairs, running, standing, bending, reaching, and the ability to lift up to 50 lbs. Candidates must be able to actively participate in all activities related to the role.
