1 Create a series of text messages between the main character in this book and a character from a different book you have read, but pretend they actually know each other.	2 Have the character you like the most write their autobiography of the time before, during, or after the story takes place.	3 Create a graph that plots the events in the character's life during the story and evaluate their importance.	4 Design a Before/After chart that shows how the main character has changed throughout the story. Include a minimum of five examples.
5 Write a eulogy for the main character. A eulogy is usually read after a person has died, but this time just tell all about the best qualities of the character even if they survived.	6 Draw and then write two post cards characters may have sent each other throughout the course of the novel.	7 Write a slogan for this book. Explain why it would represent the story by including text evidence.	8 Create a time line that depicts a minimum of 5 main events in the story. Include explanations and pictures.
9 Do you have any suggestions that would help resolve any of the conflicts in the story? Explain your ideas.	10 Do you as the reader have any information that the main character hasn't been made aware of? Write a letter to the character and fill them in!	11 Create a menu that has sandwiches named after the characters, setting and symbols in your novel. The "ingredients" can be adjectives that describe these elements.	12 Draw a map that could be included in your novel to help readers understand the settings of the main events in the story. Be sure to include captions to explain.
13 Create a word collage that describes this book. Include words that highlight the characters, themes, setting and conflict.	14 If you were turning this book into a movie, who would you cast to play the roles of the characters? Explain your answer.	15 Choose a food that could represent this story. Explain why by including details from the story.	16 Create an acrostic poem from the title of the book that provides information about the characters, setting and conflicts.
